

Safety Risk Assessment – Porthcawl Carnival 2019 Float Parade – 20th July 2019

The Safety Risk Assessment documents the potential hazards identified and associated control measures that should be implemented, for the duration of the event, to ensure that any risk is controlled to acceptable levels.

The risk measurement matrix below was used to measure the risk from each potential hazard identified.

Control measures should be clearly communicated to all affected persons participating in the event, excluding the general public.
